1. The parties estimate from present information that a trial of the matter would take up to 10 weeks (including submissions).

THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

Discovery

1. The respondent give discovery of all documents falling within categories 1, 5 and 6 of the applicant's discovery request dated 27 March 2018 by 5.00 pm on 16 May 2018.
2. The respondent give discovery of all documents falling within items 3, 10, 13 and 15 of the applicant's discovery request dated 27 March 2018 by 5.00 pm on 23 May 2018.
3. In the event that agreement is not reached between the parties on issues in dispute regarding discovery, the parties file and serve any application together with any written submissions and evidence in support of the application by 4.00 pm on 30 May 2018.
4. The parties file and serve any written submissions and evidence in reply to any application in respect of discovery made under Order 3 by 4.00 pm on 6 June 2018.



Lay evidence

5. The applicant file and serve any lay affidavits upon which he intends to rely by 4.00 pm on 30 August 2018.
6. The respondent file and serve any lay affidavits upon which it intends to rely by 4.00 pm on 21 December 2018.
7. The applicant file and serve any lay affidavits in reply upon which he intends to rely by 4.00 pm on 8 March 2019.
8. Subject to any order of the trial judge, lay evidence in the trial will be led by affidavit, with each party to notify the other by 15 March 2019 of any parts of the affidavit that the receiving party requires the witness to deliver orally at trial.

Expert reports

9. The applicant file and serve any expert reports upon which he intends to rely by 4.00 pm on 28 September 2018.
10. The respondent file and serve any expert reports upon which it intends to rely by 4.00 pm on 30 January 2019.
11. The applicant file and serve any expert reports in reply by 4.00 pm on 8 March 2019.

Common questions

12. By 13 February 2019, counsel for the parties consult and provide the trial judge with a list of common questions for the trial of the proceeding.

Case management

13. The proceeding be listed for further case management on 25 February 2019 at 9.30 am.
